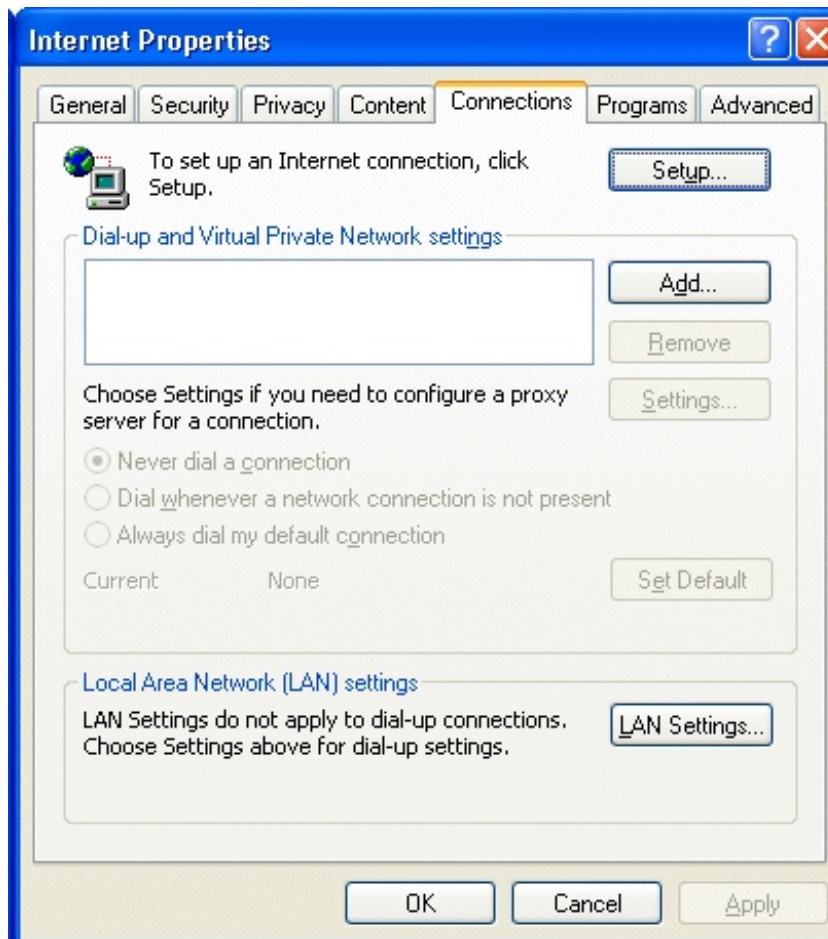


ASDM Online

Windows XP Home/Pro Setup Instructions


To make a connection to ASDM Online:

1. Click **Start**, click **Control Panel**, click **Network and Internet Connections**.
2. Click **Set up or change your Internet Connection**, click the **Setup** button and click **Next**.



3. Select **Connect to the Internet** and click **Next**.
4. Select the Option - **Setup my connection manually** and click **Next**.
5. Choose **Connect using a dial-up modem** and click **Next**.

6. Enter **ASDM Online** for the name of the new connection. Click the **Next** button.





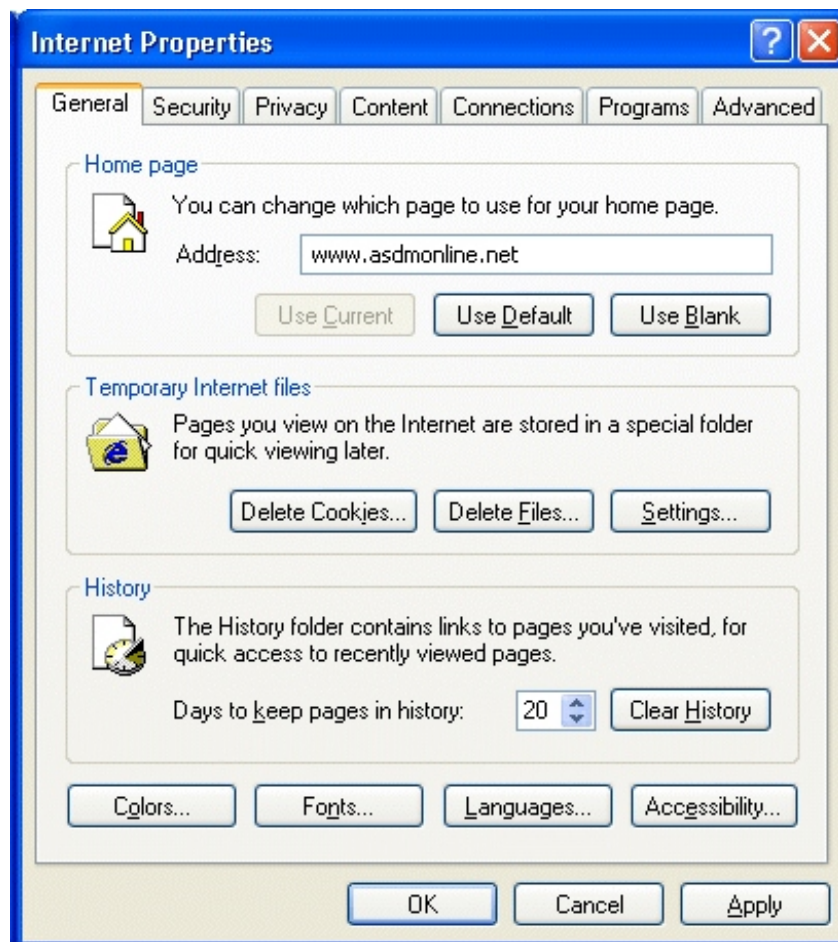
9. Click the **box** next to **Add a shortcut to this connection to my desktop** and then click the **Finish** button. You should now see a **ASDM Online** icon on your desktop.

10. Click **Start**, click **Control Panel**, click **Network and Internet Connections**.

11. Click **Internet Options**, click the **General** tab.

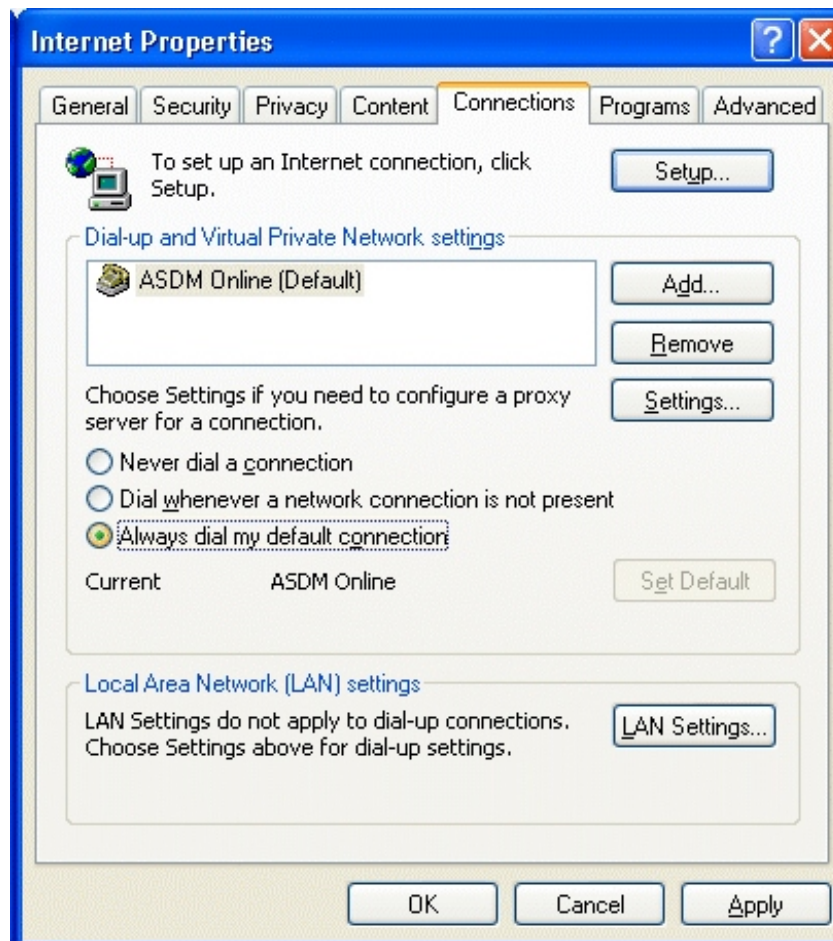


12. In the homepage box, set the address to: www.asdmonline.net as shown above.

13. Click the **Apply** button.

14. Click on the **Connections** tab.

15. Set the computer to “Always dial my default connection”.

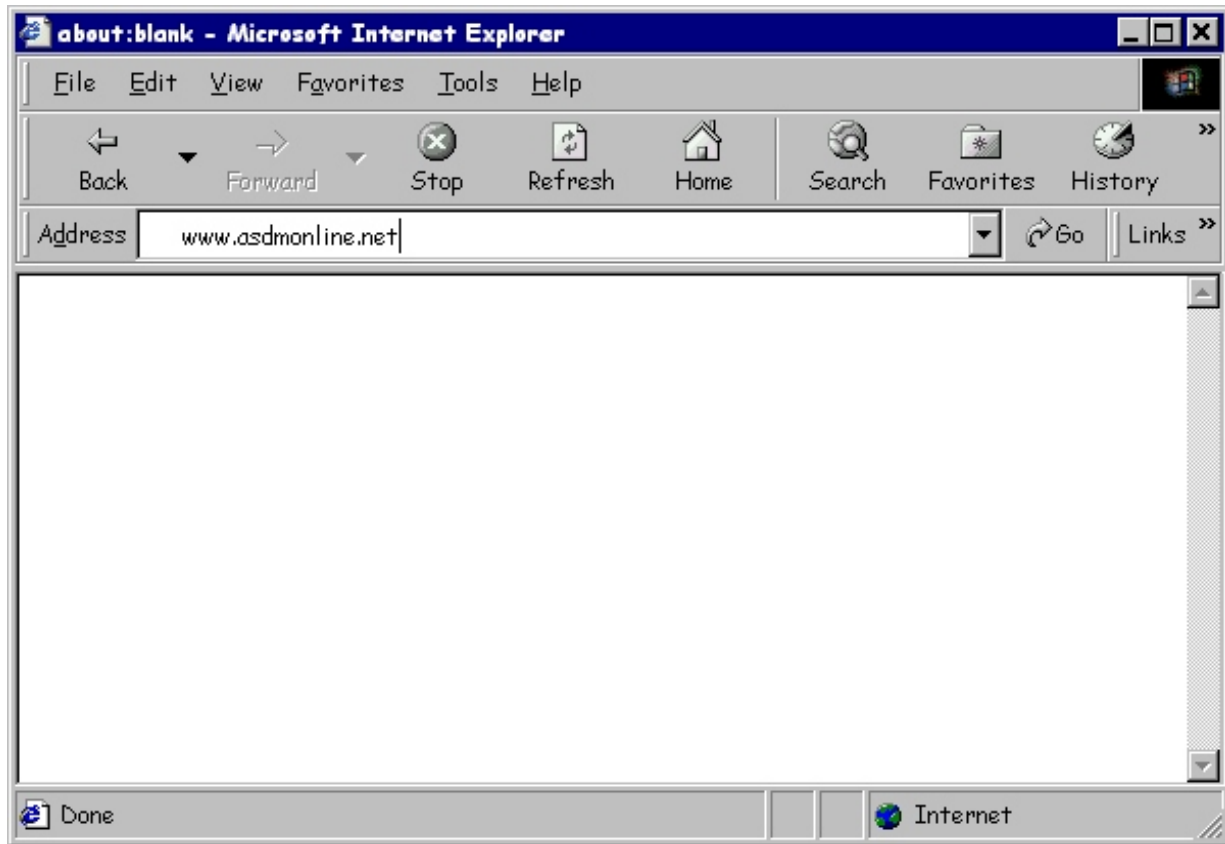


16. Make sure that the **ASDM Online** connection is the default connection. To make it the default connection, click on ASDM Online in the Dial-up setting box and then click on the “**Set Default**” button.

17. Close **OK** to close the **Control Panel** (*Do not hit the x in the top right hand corner*).

18. **You are now ready to connect to the Internet! If you cannot connect please check to make sure that your computer is dialing all 10-digits!!!**

19. Double-click on your Internet browser (**Internet Explorer** or **Netscape**) or **ASDM Online** icon on your desktop to establish the dial-in connection to us. If you use the **ASDM Online** icon, you will also need to open your browser after you are connected. Both of these browsers (Internet Explorer or Netscape) are easy to use and are similar in operation. Your screen should look something like:



In the “address area” type **www.asdmonline.net** and press the enter key on the keyboard. This will get you to the “home-base” web site for our dial-in clients. At that site you will find some useful information that will make your Internet experience a little bit easier. If you have problems connecting, call (724) 639-9990 for support.
